### How to Use XML Parts Lists with BrickLink

### If you're new to building with custom MOC instructions, welcome!

This is your exciting first step into the world of premium LEGO creations not designed or issued by The LEGO Company.

### This document is your step-by-step guide for how to acquire parts by uploading XML code to BrickLink.com and generating a "wanted list".

This means, instead of buying the parts and instructions together as a prepackaged kit, you are now in full control of your next build project!



#### **More Cost-Effective**

Avoid the added expenses of labor, inventory, and markups that come with packaged kits. Get your LEGO parts at the lowest possible price by ordering directly from BrickLink.



#### **More Choices**

Found a model design you love but wish it was in another color? The parts list makes it simpler to alter the color palette and other details to fit your personal style before buying the pieces.



#### **More Control**

Instantly access the instructions to learn how a model is built. If you already own some pieces, you can easily remove these from the shopping list and save yourself even more money.



#### **Never Sold Out!**

Most custom kits are produced in a limited run and your favorites are probably out of stock and/or retired... with Brick Replicas, you're not waiting for another batch drop to get building!

### Keep reading to get started and generate a wanted list of parts with BrickLink in 10 steps.

# 1.Open the "...XML code" .rtf document

In the download folder (usually a ZIP), **find the .rtf (rich text file) document** for the model you want to find parts for.

You want to open it with a \*very\* basic text editor, the kind of utility app that probably came with your computer:



NotePad (Windows) TextEdit (MacOS)

(This helps in the next step when you want to copy-and-paste without extra formatting being applied to your code.)

# 2. Copy all of the XML code



With your cursor ( $\triangleright$ ) clicked anywhere within the active text document, perform both of the actions below:

a) select \*all\* of the raw code which is very simple with a keyboard shortcut:



Cmd|+|A (MacOS)

b) copy the raw code which is also very simple with a keyboard shortcut:

#### b) In the dropdown menu for 'Add to:', choose Create New Wanted List and give it a name.

### 8. Paste the XML code



#### Paste \*all\* of the raw code copied from Step 2

into the text field with a keyboard shortcut:



The entire chunk of code text should be here; if you're missing any of the < > tags, go back and select/re-copy \*everything\* in the .rtf file.

If there are dashes (-) or other new text outside of the < > pairings when pasted, then your text editor is adding extra, unwanted formatting which will mess up your parts list upload process. Try a different app that will allow you to copy the text.



# 9. Proceed to verify items



...So close to done! This is where code turns into parts.

with all the XML code pasted in, click the button:

Proceed to verify items →

and you should now see a full list of parts, descriptions, quantities, colors, etc. for the given model you're building.

*If you get an error message for a specific part with a letter after the part number, try finding that part number in the .rtf file and removing the letter, then re-pasting into BrickLink.*

# Option 1: "Easy Buy" – Fast, Skip the Settings

This is the 'one-click' method of ordering everything on your wanted list.





### **Option 2: "Buy All" – Full Control for Your Carts**

This is the standard customization method for ordering everything on your wanted list.



# Tip: parts shopping for multiple models



It is highly recommended, if you are trying to get the parts for multiple models and/or accessories (e.g. my M1 Garand rifle along with its optional bayonet attachment, display stand, and info plaque), that you **upload the XML code from all of their separate .rtf documents to the same BrickLink wanted list**.

Each .rtf document's chunk of code text can be copied / uploaded one at a time; when going to 'Upload' and 'Use BrickLink XML Format', just choose to add to the same existing wanted list option in the dropdown menu.
